GINGER IN CHARGE was close-up early racing along the inside, angled out to come four-wide into stretch, took the lead leaving the eighth pole and quickly drew clear. GUIDE MY STEPS vied for the lead with AUTUMN INSPIRATION from along the outside, took the lead entering the stretch but was unable to resist GINGER IN CHARGE but proved to be second best. HAKUHIA saved ground racing in the back of the field and rallied late. PETITE ANGE hopped at the start then moved up to dispute the pace for three furlongs racing three-wide and weakened. AUTISM INSPIRATION bobbled at the start then rushed up along the inside to vie for the lead with GUIDE MY STEPS to the stretch and tired. HONEY RED was unhurried, came four-wide into the stretch then was pulled up in deep stretch and removed from the track via the equine ambulance.
