Weights 123 lbs.; Non-winners of \$22,000 in 2026 allowed 2 lbs.; Non-winners of \$15,000 in 2026 allowed 4 lbs.. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered) Starters to be named through the entry box by the closing time of entries. Field size will be limited to 12 starters. ROBIN RACER saved ground while being reserved off the pace, angled out to come three-wide into the stretch, caught CHASE nearing the sixteenth pike and won going away. CHASE tracked NOW CATO racing two-wide, took the lead from that one nearing the quarter pole but was unable to resist the winner late. SENOR TEQUILAS was forwardly placed racing three-wide, came four-wide into the stretch and finished well in a steady effort. OLE'S SURPRISE was unhurried, rallied five-wide into the stretch and went evenly late. BULL TIZ raced in the back of the field, came three-wide into the stretch and failed to seriously threaten. NOW CATO saved ground setting the pace to the quarter pole and tired. LIVIN RIGHT refused at the start then hopped when he finally broke and unseated the rider. THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE START BUT AFTER VIEWING THE FILMS MADE NO CHANGE IN THE ORDER OF FINISH.
