KYALAM saved ground setting the pace and just failed to last. FRUIT LUTES was reserved off the pace racing two-wide and finished fairly well in a steady effort. RISE UP AND GO saved ground racing in the back and rallied late along the inside. GIANT IMPACT was forwardly placed racing three-wide, came four-wide into the stretch and weakened. HACKSAW MOUNTAIN was four-wide racing in the middle of the field early, came five-wide into the stretch and tired.
