KNIGHTLINE vied with CHARLIE NEAL for the lead from along the inside, shook that one off nearing the eighth pole and maintained a safe advantage. IMPASSABLE was brushed at the start by YETA LUTE then saved ground while being unhurried, slipped through entering the stretch, angled out nearing the sixteenth pole and finished fast. CHARLIE NEAL vied with KNIGHTLINE for the early lead, could not stay with that one during the drive but held on well for third. VERDI raced in the back of the field, came six-wide into the stretch and improved his position. BLACKBERRY JAM was allowed to settle racing two-wide and failed to seriously threaten. DA SMOKE was forwardly placed to the stretch racing three-wide and tired. YETI LUTE broke in to brush IMPASSABLE then was close-up early racing along the inside, angled out to be four-wide nearing the quarter pole and gave wayt during the drive.
