FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$250 to enter, \$250 additional to start. A late penalty payment of \$750 may be made at time of entry. Purse to be divided as follows; 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% to be divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weights; Three years old 121 lbs.: Four years old and older 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$22,000 in 2026 allowed 2 lbs.; Non-winners of \$15,000 in 2026 allowed 4 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starters races not considered in weight allowances) Field size will be limited to 12 starters. High weights preferred. In Allowance Stakes preference in the draw will be based on money earned. Starters to be named through the entry box by the closing time of entries. NOMINATIONS CLOSE SUNDAY, AUGUST 2, 2026.

ALOHA BREEZE saved ground setting the pace and drew off to win with something left. PRECISE TIMING was off a step slow then worked his way forward to chase ALOHA BREEZE, could not reach that one but proved to be second best. SALEEN G T was unhurried, angled out to be five-wide nearing the quarter pole and finished in a mild rally. YOUNG LIFE LAURA was five-wide on the first turn then angled in to saved ground, offered a mild nod entering the stretch and then went evenly late. PRINCESS HEKAWI was allowed to settle racing three-wide, dropped back on the far turn, came two-wide into the stretch and failed to seriously threaten. STAY SASSY prompted ALOHA BREEZE early racing two-wide and tired.
