DIXIE'S DELIGHT saved ground setting the pace and maintained a safe advantage. LOTSA KITTY chased DIXIE'S DELIGHT racing two-wide, was unable to threaten that one but proved to be clearly second best. RUN ON OM saved ground while being allowed to settle, slipped through entering the stretch and finished in a mild rally. MAMARANDO saved ground while being unhurried and rallied late. OBSIDIAN STORM raced in the back of the field early, rallied three-wide into the stretch and improved her position. GARY'S ECHO was prominently placed early racing two-wide and weakened. OUR HULA GIRL was forwardly placed early racing three-wide and tired. SECRET HOTTIE was three-wide racing in the middle of the field, came five-wide into the stretch and gave way.
