MAKE MO MINE unhurried early, rallied four-wide into the stretch, took the lead nearing the eighth pole and quickly drew clear. PLAYA LUNA dueled for the early lead from between MATTIE GOINCOASTAL and KINGSTOWN MAYOR, dropped back slightly on the turn, came three-wide into the stretch and finished well in a steady effort. CHAMPAGNE DELIGHT saved ground while being allowed to settle, slipped through entering the stretch and finished in a mild rally. MATTIE GOINCOASTAL dueled for the early lead from along the inside, opened a clear lead mearing the quarter pole then set the pace to near the eighth pole and weakened. START DREAMIN settled in the back of the field, came five-wide into the stretch and rallied late. KINGSTOWN MAYOR disputed the early pace racing three-wide and tired.
