POP CHART stalked the pace racing two-wide, came four-wide into the stretch and was up in the final sixteenth to win going away. SORORITY PARTY vied with CALY BALI for the lead from along the inside, dropped back slightly on the turn, angled out to come two-wide into the stretch and finished well for second in a game try. CANDIED JOULE broke in then raced in the back of the field, came two-wide into the stretch and rallied late. CALY BALI broke out and bumped DREWY at the start then vied with SORORITY PARTY for the lead from along the outside, shook that one off to open a clear lead nearing the quarter pole, angled in for the drive and weakened slightly late. CHEERING FOR LAYLA was reserved off the pace, rallied five-wide into the stretch and then went evenly late. DREWY was bmp at the CALY BALI then settled in the middle of the field racing three-wide, came five-wide into the stretch and

lacked a rally. BEVERLY T saved ground chasing the early pace and tired. DAME LORRAINE saved ground while being settle and failed to seriously threaten. MY LITTLE LADY was in tight shortly after the stretch then was unhurried, raced three-wide on the turn and was not a factor.
