CALY BALI broke out and bumped DREWY at the start then vied with SORORITY PARTY for the lead from along the outside, shook that one off to open a clear lead nearing the quarter pole, angled in for the drive and weakened slightly late. CHEERING FOR LAYLA was reserved off the pace, rallied five-wide into the stretch and then went evenly late. DREWY was bmp at the CALY BALI then settled in the middle of the field racing three-wide, came five-wide into the stretch and
