JULLIAN IN PARIS was unhurried early, rallied five-wide at the quarter pole, came in nearing the sixteenth pole while catching SIR LUCAS and prevailed under strong handling. PEDAL TO THE METAL prompted SIR LUCAS from along the inside, angled out to be three-wide entering the stretch, then altered course further out nearing the sixteenth pole when JULIAN IN PARIS came in and finished strongly. SIR LUCAS set the early pace under pressure from PEDAL TO THE MEDAL, opened a clear lead entering the stretch but was unable to hold off the top two late in a game try. MR. EXECUTIVE was forwardly placed racing 2-w, angled in nearing the eighth pole but lacked the needed late response. FREE AGAIN saved ground while being allowed to settle, moved up three-wide nearing the quarter pole and then went evenly late. PURE CANE SUGAR was three-wide racing in the middle of the field early and weakened during the drive. JUST GOTTA SHINE was forwardly placed from the start racing four-wide and tired. DEKUDYLAN raced in the back of the field early, came three-wide into the stretch and failed to seriously threaten. THE RIDER OF PEDAL TO THE METAL LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST JULIAN IN PARIS BUT AFTER VIEWING THE FILMS THE STEWARDS RULED THE INCIDENT DID NOT COAST PEDAL TO THE METAL A PLACING AND MADE NO CHANGE IN THE ORDER OF FINISH.
