SLEW'S TIZ WHIZ saved ground stalking the pace, slipped through nearing the eighth pole and finished fast to be up in the final strides. BEARINGS was unhurried early, rallied five-wide into the stretch and finished strongly in a game effort. CLOVISCONNECTION vied with HE'S NOT TALKING for the lead from along the inside, drifted out to be two-wide entering the stretch, then responded during the drive and held on determinedly to the wire. HE'S NOT TALKING vied with CLOVISCONNECTION for the early lead, gained a slight advantage entering the stretch but wasn't quite good enough in a steady effort. VERITAS AEQUITAS raced in the middle of the field while three-wide and weakened slightly late. CATCH A BREEZE dropped back early then was eased nearing the stretch and walked off following the race.
