HI YAH pressed the pace, forwardly placed throughout, dueled down the home stretch and drove clear late. PRADO'S PRIORITY went to the front, moved to the rail down the backside, saved ground around the turn, dueled down the lane, was outfinished for the win, but proved best of others. AMERICAN GUY raced within contention, steadied down the backside, getting in tight quarters, made a late bid and was a clear third at the wire. DRILLING REPORT void of early speed, showed late interest, but was no real factor. THE BOSS SOSS raced near the middle of the pack, steadied slightly, getting in tight quarters and lacked a late kick. MARKS PROMISE showed early speed, faded and was no threat late. STOVALL always raced near the back and showed little. OCEOLA raced near the back, steadied down the backside, getting in tight quarters and trailed. THE TRAINER OF #2 THE BOSS SOSS LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST #9 PRADO'S PRIORITY FOR INTERFERENCE LATE DOWN THE BACKSIDE. AFTER VIEWING REPLAYS STEWARDS TOOK NO ACTION.
