BOOTS AN DIAMONDS was under pressure throughout and held under strong handling while fully extended. JADE'S WICKED DOLL brushed after the start, pressed the pace two across, went willingly to the wire and didn't have enough late. LITTLE BIT O STORM raced inside early, angled out into the turn, bid seven wide, closed steadily and was gaining fast late. GOOD BY FAITH stalked the pace while racing along the inside, lacked room and was taken back on the turn, came again and finished well. QUIET MELODY stalked the pace, bid willingly to loom a threat and hung late. KANCANCUTIE brushed after the start, was in tight near the half mile pole, went ten wide at the top of the stretch and finished evenly. IFUAINFIRSTURLAST was never far back, put in an even effort and failed to threaten. UTHINKICARE was steadied along the rail just past the chute, ran up behind horses and was steadied again near the half pole, went nine wide at the top of the stretch and lacked a bid.
