WEEKENDSANDWHISKEY unhurried in the early stages, advanced outside of rivals into the backstretch run, chased the leading ground into the far turn then angled out and loomed four wide to upper stretch, took command into the final furlong and pulled away late under moderate urging. TOOGOODTOSELL settled to the first turn, saved ground along the backstretch then got crowded a bit nearing the far turn, angled four wide to upper stretch, could not impact the winner into the stretch drive but stayed on late and was best of the rest. MATINEE IDOL away in good order and prominent away from the start, pressed the decent pace along the backstretch, dueled into the far turn then took command nearing the quarter marker, led to upper stretch then was overhauled by the winner inside of the furlong pole, could not keep pace with WEEKENDSANDWHISKEY to the final sixteenth, was outkicked late for the place honors and was well clear for the show. MO WHISKEY settled in the second flight, tracked the pace while never far back along the backstretch, roused into the far turn then chased three wide nearing the quarter marker, needed more into the stretch drive and weakened in the final furlong. CUSTOM RIDE settled outside of rivals into the first turn, lost position into the backstretch then trailed at the half-mile, swung five wide into upper stretch and passed tiring rivals late. SPIELMAN settled in the second flight and four wide early on, went up to track the decent pace along the backstretch run, chased into the far turn, could not muster the needed response at the quarter pole then gave way in the stretch. KOHEN THE MAN sent to vie for the early lead, took a narrow lead then set a disputed pace to the backstretch, carved out decent fractions to the half-mile, dueled into the far turn then was repelled nearing the quarter marker, could not find more into the stretch drive and tired. CATALINA GOLD was forwardly placed away from the start, tracked the early pace three deep, lost ground nearing the half-mile marker, stopped into the far turn, was eased through the lane and walked off.
