SEEHOSS broke well, vied up front closest to the inside through the first turn, set a pressured pace up the backstretch and into the far turn while remaining along the rail, garnered a slightly larger advantage by late in the final bend, turned back a mild bid through upper stretch then held sway through the final furlong under steady handling. CRIMSON STORM in the second group for a half outside, advanced into a striking position while four wide through the second turn, lodged a mild bid outside the winner when straightened for home then could not follow through, held sway for the second spot. UXMAL behind the lead pack toward the rail, idled along while between horses in the second turn, behind the winner through upper stretch, not enough for the place. TAPPIN FORA DANCE prompted the issue for five furlongs while three wide and between horses, lost some position in traffic late in the second turn, set down for the drive, improved position the final furlong with some mild late interest, not a serious threat. BIRTHDAY PARTY back off the pace while outside, continued back into the far turn, four to five wide turning for home, improved outside of rivals through upper stretch then went flat the final furlong. B MINOR

void of speed, remained well back second turn, passed some tiring rivals through the lane with some belated interest. SAMURAI'S GRANDSON forwardly placed while four wide first turn, continued to prompt the issue the middle half mile, chased the winner out of the final turn and gave way. GOLDEN GLIDER back off the early leaders, moved closer along the rail late backstretch, waited in some traffic soon after, continued to save ground while covered up in the second turn then came up lacking when clear for the drive. SOPHIE'S PAINTER lacked early foot well out in the strip, five to six wide into the lane, failed to muster a rally. KHOZY MY BOY was finished after a half.
