NOLA QUEEN pressed the pace to the turn, challenged for the lead, dueled through the stretch and proved best. KORNER STOMP stumbled and bumped at the start while getting away well, set the pace to the turn, responded when challenged to duel through the stretch and was outfinished in a good effort. BAR CAR pressed the pace, dropped back on the turn and swung wide, closed steadily and got up for show. MY HINTOF PLATINUM was crowded at the start, raced close to the pace along the inside, bid along the rail on the turn, was within range, lacked the needed late response and was outfinished for third. COPPER KEY raced mid pack, swung wide leaving the turn, put in a steady effort and failed to threaten. COPY THIS was crowded at the start and outrun. EXCUSEMELADY'S bumped at the start and was outrun in an even effort. GREY STRAT hesitated and veered out at the start, fell far back, trailed the field and passed a tiring rival. BAYOU BABY broke out and was crowded at the start, showed brief speed along the rail, dropped back and swung wide entering the stretch.
