LOUDERMILK broke well from along the inside, narrowly set the early pace, duelled into the turn closest to the inside, put the other speed away entering the stretch and maintained a comfortable advantage to he wire under steady handling. BIND FAITH back off the early pace off the inside, in some traffic entering the turn, moved out to four wide through the bend, advanced to be widest of the second flight into the lane, could do little with the winner to the wire, held sway for the second spot. SOPHIE'S PAINTER in the second flight while between horses, came in the two path for the drive, displayed some mild interest to finish up best of the rest. DREWMAZING in the second group while racing outside, three wide and between horses into the lane, lacked a closing response. MOTEL PATEL away in good order just outside outside the winner, pressed that one early briefly, fell back along the inside into the turn, one paced stretch. CAPTIVATING BOY in tight at the break and a few strides after, was used to move up and duel with the winner into the turn while outside that one, gave way in the drive. WESTERN AVENUE last away, continued to trail throughout, was never a threat.
