MASTEROFFFOXHOUNDS broke forwardly, dueled into and through the first turn through a soft opening quarter, continued to help set a leisurely pace for a half, edged clear into the far turn, maintained daylight through that bend then drew off through the stretch to win ridden out in a solid effort. HIGHLAND CREEK settled off the pace while racing outside, moved closer to join the second flight four wide late in the final turn losing some ground to inner rivals into the straight, up late for the runner up position while never a threat to the winner. TONTERRIA broke in to tighten up a couple of inner rivals, was straightened to help show the way through the first turn closest to the inside, alternated on to the backstretch, fell off the winner before a half, chased that one into the far turn, vied in the second group into the lane, held stubbornly for the second position only to be overtaken late. HEGS in the second group early, moved out a bit and stalked the duel up front up the backstretch three wide, continued in the three path final turn, went flat through the lane to finish up evenly. WOODS N WATER void of any early speed, came three wide for the drive, bettered position a bit with some modest late interest. PLAY MO off the early pace while three wide first turn, moved inside and saved ground through much of the second turn, cut the corner into the straight to improve then failed to sustain that advance to the wire. WILTON floated in at the start, trailed for the first five furlongs, inside second turn, also cut the corner into the lane to improve then

flattened out as well. CHENTI went one paced near the back and failed to muster a rally. CHAOSMOS in tight and shuffled back at the start, moved out when well off the pace to be four wide through the first turn, continued well out in the course and was five wide through the second bend, remained back. OUR MAJESTIC was finished early to trail home.
