KNOCKED OUT settled in behind PIP SQUEEK to the turn, moved up approaching the quarter pole to bid for the lead, engaged in a spirited duel through the stretch with the inside rival unrelenting, but got a favorable bob at the wire to prevail. PIP SQUEEK took command early and appeared to be traveling well through the turn, flagged the tail passing the five-sixteenths marker, then battled back when KNOCKED OUT came alongside to challenge at the quarter pole, held firm in a furious duel through the final stages, but came up on the short end of the photo at the finish. DAY FOR THE GRAY saved ground throughout and was mildly gaining in the stretch to capture the minor award. MISS ROSIE raced three-wide in the middle of the pack and lacked a finish. CLEVER RACE chased the top pair in third position to the stretch and faltered. TOM'S GIRL dropped far back early and did not offer a rally. BOLD EXAGGERATION was outrun, raced three-wide throughout, and never threatened.
