CHICANERY broke in the air and bumped at the start, advanced to the turn, assumed command and drew off in the drive under urging. THE PETITIONER was hustled along inside to vie to the turn, dropped back entering the stretch, continued willingly and was no match late. DAAT bumped on both sides at the start, bid between horses on the turn, lacked a rally and held safely for show. ACESRAISEDTHE BAR broke out, was slow early and improved position in a steady effort. SKY WITNESS broke in, led briefly early, vied to the turn and gave way. NOISEMAKER was crowded and bumped at the start, lagged early, bid along the rail on the turn and lacked a response. PHCHAMPAGNEJOURNEY broke in, raced close to the pace towards the outside, went four wide entering the turn and flattened out. DR. NEUJAHR was checked at the start, trailed the field and showed little.
