STOVALL chased inside foes toward the rear of midpack in a compact field, was urged two and then three wide on the turn, continued to gradually angle out to come into the lane four wide, sustained a rally under a drive in upper stretch, drifted in a few paths and ran on best to the wire. JOHNNY PODRES broke with the field but soon trailed, edged closer inside foes into the turn, improved inside around the turn, came into the lane inside just behind the leading line, took up behind BLIND FAITH in upper stretch, switched two wide, resumed his rally and ran on with interest to the finish. BIND FAITH took a narrow lead inside early though was soon headed by KNOCKALITTLELOUNDER, hounded inside KNOCKALITTLELOUNDER into the turn, took a narrow lead approaching the five sixteenths, was driven two wide in upper stretch, was headed near the furlong mark and flattened late. GRAZEN BOY chased four deep toward the rear early, chased six wide on the turn, came into the lean near the center of the course, and drove past tiring horses late. BIG NICKEL came away between horses near the front of the pack, settled back approaching the nine sixteenths, raced three wide between horses on the turn and settled back toward the rear of the main group, was driven inside into the lane, and chased mildly past tiring foes. WHISKEY AND EASY was forward between horses early, let BIND FAITH and KNOCKALITTLELOUNDER take the initiative into the turn, was pushed for a three wide bid near the three eighths, came three wide into the stretch in range, chased on in range to midstretch and weakened between horses. SONO chased four wide, was driven five wide into the lane, and had no kick. GAME PORT chased three deep toward the rear early, continued five wide around the turn, came six wide into upper stretch,

and had no rally. DEWCLAW trailed down the back straight and in the four to five path around the turn and offered no rally in the lane. KNOCKALITTLELOUDER broke well, vied for the lead three wide early, shook to a narrow lead two wide into the turn, was headed at the five sixteenths and emptied out between foes.

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
