GOLDEN GLIDER veered out and bumped at the start, advanced to the second turn, challenged three across, swung out, dueled past the eighth pole, inched clear, drifted out and held while fully extended. HEY BOSS brushed at the start, was unhurried early, advanced to the turn, bid six wide, angled in mid stretch, closed steadily and was gaining late. ORDER UP pressed the pace two across, challenged for the lead on the turn, dueled past the eighth pole, faltered and settled for show. EL PERFECTO bumped and was squeezed at the start, raced in the second flight, advanced to the turn, loomed a threat, was checked and gave way. RANCH WATER set a pressured pace to the second turn and flattened out. SILVER REDESDALE ducked out at the start, raced in the second flight, showed speed to the second turn, tired and gave way. BIGFOOT SIGHTING was rated early, saved ground, showed little and was not urged late.
