MR. FAVERSHAM saved ground, bid between horses on the turn, angled in for the drive, got a head in front past the eighth pole and inched clear late. CRIMSON STORM went five wide entering the first turn, vied three across to the second turn, drew clear, led past the eighth pole and was outclosed to finish second best. SAINT PETER'S BAY settled off the pace, rallied four wide on the turn, bid and hung. BIRTHDAY PARTY was unhurried early and improved position in a steady effort. PICO D'ORO brushed at the start, vied between horses, dropped back into the second turn and leveled off. TAPPIN FORA DANCE broke out and brushed at the start, pressed the pace along the inside, tired into the turn and gave way.
