HALF GUILTY pressed the pace five wide, challenged for the lead on the turn, went willingly to the wire and couldn't get by the winner. MY CHULUPA raced in close along the inside, awaited room on the turn, closed along the rail and earned show. NOVA'S RETURN was slow early, raced inside and finished well under steady urging. ONE MORE SLEEP raced mid pack in an outside trip and lacked a stretch response. TRIPPIN ON BEAUTY pressed the pace between horses to the turn and gave way. A THOUSAND ARROWS broke awkwardly to be off a step slow and failed to menace in a wide trip. KNIGHT'S GOLD trailed the field and passed a tiring rival. ZAPAWAY pressed the pace between horses to the turn, stopped and was not urged late.
