INDIAN CAT rated on the inside, split foes in the final furlong to surge clear. WAR DEPT CALLING bumped at the start, raced behind the pace in the three path, pressed the pace at the top of the stretch but was unable to close the distance. ASAASY rated three wide, advanced through the far turn to give a mild rally in the stretch. TEXAS ADOPTER settled back to trail early, angled out five wide in the stretch to find best stride late. IT'S A SECRET raced off the pace, made an inside bid at the gap but had no closing bid. GOROSTIETA'S LOVE bumped at the start, rated in the two path, made no bid. FINAL HALF bumped at the start, rushed to the lead in the two path, vied with foe up the backstretch, yielded the lead in the final sixteenth, pinched back in the final few strides. THISGUYCANFLY trailed for most, passed tiring foes in the stretch. A TRUE TARGET raced off the pace, made no impact. GONE ELVIS bumped at the start, rushed to vie for the lead on the inside, retreated in the final furlong.
