ALVARADO CAT saved ground to press the pace from the two path, took command of the lead at the three eighths pole, kicked clear in the stretch. NATIVE RED bumped at the start, settled off the pace between foes, split foes in the stretch to rally for the place award. SARAH'S RUNNER bumped at the start to trail early, advanced along the outside of the turn and stretch to improve position. SOPHIE'S PAINTER raced off the pace on the inside, angled towards the outside of the stretch to pass tired foes. HANDSOME HAROLD settled behind the pace, weakened in the stretch. TSUPERMAN stalked the pace three wide early, dropped back to take the inside of the turn, weakened in the stretch. FLASHY BOY took the early lead on the inside, relinquished the lead at the three eighths, faded in the stretch.
