BOURBON DELIGHT bumped at the break, soon had the lead, showed the way just off the rail, was challenged leaving the second turn, fought gamely in the stretch, did not have enough left but proved easily second best. COPPER CROSSING chased running widest, moved clear for third after a half mile, came widest into the lane and could only just hold his position late. LOOK AWAY void of speed, though hustled from the gate, picked up his pace after a half mile, came off the rail some entering the stretch and was getting to the wiring COPPER CROSSING in the waning yards. READY REDDING broke inward, bumping BOURBON DELIGHT, gradually faded from inside, was unresponsive in the stretch and in hand in the late going.

YOU'RE IN COREY without early speed, angled out taking the bend, drifted out entering the lane, steadily drifted out making his bid in the stretch but took over second with seventy yards left. CRANKSHAFT shared the lead outside FASTNFURIOUS, took over nearing the quarter pole, was clear entering the lane but began to wear down upper stretch. FASTNFURIOUS displayed early speed from inside then faded after three and a half furlongs.

WINDIGO SPIRIT steadily angled in as he vied for the early lead, bumped MEDAL OF FACT midway on the backstretch then gave way three wide on the turn.
