JULYNNE moved off the rail some trying to gain a clear path soon after the break, waited from inside on the bend, got through along the rail entering the lane, moved clear inside the last eighth and held sway. BIG SALLY broke on top then steadily angled inward, was challenged from outside on the turn then from both sides upper stretch and gradually wore down. CANDY LOOKER vied for the early lead, was checked and altered out when BIG SALLY took her path just past the five-furlong pole, came again to that one two wide on the bend, dueled through the stretch but did not have enough left in the late going. GHALY POSSE prominent from outside from the beginning, began to wear down and lug in deep stretch.
