KNOTTY AND NICE set the pace, had a clear lead on the far turn and was much the best. HOT OMELET stalked the early leader and had a good position on the far turn but was no match for the winner. DOMER ALLURE was in range, saved ground on the far turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch held show. CANDID CANDACE was unhurried early and gained ground on the far turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch was no real threat. IRON PYRITE was in touch but chased on the far turn and had no kick. INITTOWINIT showed no early speed and moved up on the far turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch had no rally. MISS OZEGE tracked the early leaders and was roused from the inside on the far turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch leveled off. LITTLE IRIS was off the pace, showed little and from the five path at the top of the stretch had no impact.
