SIGNATURE RING showed speed from the outside, had a clear lead on the turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch proved best. CHROME'S BIG BREAK was away alertly and roused on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch was no match for the winner. FAIRHOPECURLY was in touch, hustled along on the turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch finished well on the rail. SOUPER COP was in range and raced evenly on the turn but from the seven path at the top of the stretch was no real threat. STRIKE A CHORD was hustled early and a factor on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch had nothing left. SIGIRIYA was well back and saved ground on the turn but had no impact.
