A LA CARTE stalked the early leader from the outside, dueled on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch drew clear. MAGICAL CHAMPAGNE was away alertly, roused on the turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch was second best. VIDEO EVIDENCE was hustled early and had a slim lead on the turn but gave way at the top of the stretch. KENTUCKY BILL was off slow, chased on the turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch was no threat. PALMILLA'S BET was off the pace and saved ground on the turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch was not a factor.
