Z HUB was in range, roused on the turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch was up in time. HARD PERFORMER set the pace and had a clear lead on the turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch was caught late. PELEE ISLAND was in touch and a factor on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch needed more. ZIP TO ZAP was off the pace, had a mild gain on the turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch finished well. COMMON CANTER was in mid pack but chased on the turn and failed to fire. CHARITY FIRST was well back and closed the gap on the turn but was never a threat. WE COME IN PEACE tracked the early leaders from the inside but lost ground on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch was empty.
