SILENT PASSION was in touch, moved up on the turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch drew clear. AMERICAN OF COURSE set the pace and had a clear lead on the turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch gave way. SHAMRA was in range, roused on the turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch was up for show. FRAC AMOUR stalked the early leader and was a factor on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch had no late kick. LITTLE FIRE was well back and hustled along on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch was not a factor. NO VISOR was off the pace and saved ground on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch was eased to the wire.
