MYMATHES CORRECT showed speed and set the pace, had the lead on the turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch fought gamely for the win. GLINTINDADDYSEYE stalked the early leader, was a factor on the turn and vied from the five path through the stretch but was no match for the winner. HEARD A GHOST was in range and hustled along on the turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch needed more. CATHOLIC JACKIE was in touch and roused on the turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch had no response. TIMES A BREEZE was off the pace, showed little and from the seven path at the top of the stretch was not a factor. DIOMEDES tracked the early leaders from the outside but lost ground on the turn and was eased to the wire.
