CANDID CANDACE stalked the early leader, had the lead on the far turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch held sway. VOICE FROM ABOVE was in touch, moved up on the far turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch was clearly second best. IRON PYRITE set the pace and had a good position on the far turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch finished evenly. MY CASH FACTOR was unhurried early and roused on the far turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch had no response. LITTLE IRIS was in range early but trailed the field on the far turn and was not a factor.
