ILIKEITWHENITSNOWS was in touch, moved up on the far turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch fought gamely for the win. GO GO ALEXANDER set the pace, had a slim lead on the far turn and vied through the stretch but was outgunned. SUNSET SKIPPY was off the pace, trailed the field on the far turn and was up for show. ZIMBAWEE was in range and had a mild gain on the far turn but from the seven path at the top of the stretch was no real threat. GALILEO STREET was up close early but chased on the far turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch flattened out. WHISKYTANGODISCO stalked the early leader and forced the pace on the far turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch had nothing left.
