Horses not originally nominated may supplement at time of final entry by a non-refundable fee of \$640 which includes the entry fee. Weights: Three Year Olds, 120 lbs. Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of three races in 2026 allowed, 2 lbs. (Races with claiming prices of \$6,250 or less not considered for allowances). The field will be limited to 12 starters. If more than 12 entries pass the entry box, preference will be given to the highest earnings in 2025-2026. Final entries to be madethrough the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. (Colts and Geldings Preferred) This is a non Black Type Race. Closed Monday, August 24th. with 11 Nominations.

STYLISH GENT was away alertly, set the pace, had a clear lead on the turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch prevailed. PAT'S GAMBLE was unhurried early, moved up on the turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch just missed. MIA AND ME was off slow and a factor on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch was outfinished. KIDDIE HOLIDAY was in range and roused from between foes on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch finished evenly. ALWAYS A WAY was in touch and raced evenly on the turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch had no rally. SHORT STORY LONG was off the pace and showed little while outrun.
