FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD THAT HAVE STARTED AT FORT ERIE TWO TIMES OR MORE IN 2026. By subscription of \$50 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional \$250 when making entry with a purse of \$32,000 Guaranteed (Plus up to \$6,400 for eligible Ontario Breds). Horses not originally nominated may supplement at time of final entry by a non-refundable fee of \$640 which includes the entry fee. Weights: Three Year Olds, 120 lbs. Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of three races at a mile or over in 2026 allowed, 2 lbs. (Races with claiming prices of \$6,250 or less not considered for allowances). The field will be limited to 12 starters. If more than 12 entries pass the entry box, preference will be given to the highest earnings in 2025-2026. This race will not be divided. Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. This is a non Black Type race. This race will run on the Turf Course weather permitting. Closed Monday, August 24th. with 16 Nominations. If deemed inadvisable by management to run on the turf, this race will be run at a distance of One Mile and One Sixteenth on the main track.

VOICE FROM ABOVE was unhurried early, had a mild gain on the far turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch was kept to task. ALTA CALIBRE showed speed from the inside and had a slim lead on the far turn but was no match for the winner. PERIWINKLE was in range, moved up on the far turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch finished well. DREAMS AND SCHEMES settled off the pace, trailed the field on the far turn and rallied

late. BUILT DIFFERENT was well back and gained ground on the far turn but from the seven path at the top of the stretch needed more. CANDID CANDACE showed no early speed, raced evenly on the far turn and from the eight path at the top of the stretch had no late kick. NO VISOR was off the pace and hustled along on the far turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch was no real threat. HOT OMELET stalked the early leaders and had a good position on the far turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch flattened out. COACH CALEY (IRE) was in mid pack but chased on the far turn and faded. KNOTTY AND NICE was away alertly and a factor on the far turn but dropped back through the stretch. YA NO was in touch early but lost ground on the far turn, was outdistanced and walked off.
