GHOST BUSTED showed speed from the inside, took command on the turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch was much the best. COMETOTHE DARKSIDE was hustled early and a factor on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch was no match for the winner. BOLSHOYE SPASIBO was in touch and roused on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch needed more. LAST RIDE was in range and raced evenly on the turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch was no real threat. CALLING HOME was unhurried early and hustled along on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch failed to fire. MONSTER MACHINE was well back and closed the gap on the turn but from the seven path at the top of the stretch was not a factor. ONE SMOOTH STONE was off the pace, showed little and was never in contention.
