VERY DEBONAIRE was in touch, had a good inside position on the turn and with a bid in mid stretch drew clear. FIFTY B M G stalked the early leader and was a factor on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch was outfinished. WET AND WILD was unhurried early, had a mild gain on the turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch finished well. HEAVYLIKEACHEVY showed speed from the outside and had the lead on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch failed to hold. HARPER CITY was well back and closed the gap on the turn but was not a factor. FOREST FLASH was in range but chased on the turn and from the the three path at the top of the stretch flattened out.
