LET'S GO LIAM settled off the pace, had a mild gain on the turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch rallied in time. ARAMI'S SPEIGHSTER showed speed from the inside, had a slim lead on the turn and vied through the stretch in good effort. SMARTER STILL stalked the early leader and dueled on the turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch was outfinished. SASSAGOULA RIVER was in touch and a factor on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch needed more. ZIMBAWEE was off the pace and hustled along on the turn but was not a factor. Z HUB was in range early and saved ground on the turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch was no threat.
