HOT OMELET set the pace, had the lead on the far turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch fought gamely for the win. MY TWO AUNT JOANS stalked the early leader and was a factor on the far turn but from the seven path at the top of the stretch was outgunned. LITTLE FIRE settled off the early leaders, was hustled along on the far turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch was up for show. THELONIOUS was in range and roused on the far turn but had no response. MISTER MESEEKS was in touch and raced evenly on the far turn but failed to fire. REDOUTE'S LIGHT was well back and showed nothing in a dull effort.
