SCAT FACTOR was off the pace, gained ground on the far turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch fought gamely for the win. SUNRISE DRIVE was unhurried early, had a mild gain on the far turn and a bid in mid stretch but was outfinished. HIATUS set the pace and had the lead on the far turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch gave way. MORAL TURPITUDE forced the early pace and was a factor on the far turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch had nothing left. FAST AND READY tracked the early leaders and was roused on the far turn but had no late kick. YORKVILLE was in mid pack but lost ground on the far turn and had no impact.
