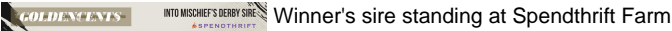

GOLDEN TEST showed speed from the inside, had a clear lead on the turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch held sway. AWE INSPIRED was unhurried early, had a mild gain on the turn and was up for place. RED IN FRONT stalked the early leader and was a factor on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch needed more. HEARD A GHOST was away alertly and raced evenly on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch was no real threat. CLIVE CROSS was hustled early and roused from the inside on the turn but had no response.
