FOR FOUR YEARS OLDS AND UPWARD, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED. Free nomination by Saturday, December 27. \$550 to enter, \$550 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$2,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees.

\$100,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 124 lbs.
Non-winners of Sweepstakes since January 10, 2025, allowed 2 lbs, \$25,000 since October 10 allowed 4 lbs, \$15,000 since then allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, and starter races not considered in estimating allowances.) Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. First preference to stakes winners, second preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2025 and then horses with the highest lifetime earnings. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or supplementary nomination fee if applicable. EL DINERO settled off the pace four wide, drove down the stretch to lock in battle with HAY JUDE in the final sixteenth, inched clear for the victory. HAY JUDE set a pressured pace from the inside, opened up a few in the upper stretch, was challenged to duel in the final sixteenth but grudgingly gave way for a gamely finish. SIR WELLINGTON trailed shortly after the start, took towards the outside of the stretch and closed willingly to be up for the show award. CARPIS pressed the early pace, backed off in the turn, took towards the inside at the eighth but was out-finished by foes. STRONG PROMISE raced in the middle of the pack between foes, failed to menace. BENOIT raced off the pace on the inside, closed some ground down the stretch to make minor improvements. SOUNDS LIKE POWER tracked the pace four wide, weakened down the stretch. BRON AND BROW tracked the pace from the inside, faded down the stretch.
