DANZIG'S DORA broke swiftly before opting to press the pace three wide, reclaimed command at the quarter, kicked clear to be much the best. LOLITA J was rated between rivals, backed off through the turn to trail at the quarter, improved through traffic to get up for the place award. M K'S ROCKETTE was bumped at the start, raced off the pace, improved along the outside of the stretch for the show award. PAM'S FRIEND took charge of a pressured pace from the inside, gave way at the quarter, weakened down the stretch. HELENA BABY was bumped at the start, rated on the inside, steadied approaching the half, angled out six wide to make minor improvements. ICE COLD BLONDE was bumped at the start, trailed for most, passed tiring foes. PROMESA DIVINA sat behind the pace on the inside, took a slight hold just before the half, tipped out three wide in the stretch and weakened then on. HONOR AND OBAY was bumped at the start, tracked the pace four wide, retreated in the stretch.
