LASER CLAD was unruly loading, leaned outwardly at the start, showed the way in the two path, clung to an advantage from a pair of outer bidders turning for home, inched an advantage in upper stretch, dug in while meeting an inner challenge in the final furlong and held firm. CUSTOM'S CLEARED stalked behind the leaders while a path off of the inside, chased the clearing pace setter through upper stretch, progressed to bid inside of that one leaving the furlong grounds but was fended off. THE WICKED CAT bobbled and veered inwardly into open space at the start, stalked outside of the top pair and from the four path, ranged up to bid turning for home, chased in the six path in upper stretch, flopped back to his left lead at the furlong grounds, ran on while lugging inwardly entering the final sixteenth and pursued evenly. RUNNING RAGGED prompted outside of the leader and from the three path, vied as an outer rival bid turning for home, failed to keep pace with his inner counterpart and chased in teh five path in upper stretch, but yielded between horses in the final furlong before saving fourth. CUSTOM RIDE hesitated when the gates sprung and spotted the leaders multiple lengths at the start, rushed forward outside of rivals approaching the half mile pole, chased from midpack while tucking from the three to two path around the turn, then stayed on willingly along the inside to miss fourth. VINEAUX missed the break and was off slow, pursued off of the pace in the four to three path and failed to factor. BANDIDO DEAL trailed in the two path and made little impact. HE'S A REAL OUTFIT broke slowly, raced well back in the three path and never got involved. V CUT chased from midpack along the inside early on, then faded around the turn.

AGENT CREED showed the way a path off of the rail while being prompted by an outer rival, met that foe's challenge entering the lane, gamely clung to an advantage from that one while dueling into deep stretch and narrowly held. BREAKING ALONE pressed outside of the eventual winner and from the three path, bid entering lane, dueled gamely but narrowly missed. WRITE OFF JERRY settled off of the pace along the inside, then in the two path around teh far turn before swinging out to the five path entering the lane, launched a rally in upper stretch, flopped back to his left lead nearing the final sixteenth, sustained progress closing in outside of the leaders late but needed more to reel them in. MAASAI WARRIOR stalked along the inside while tugging in the bit, then chased through midstretch and subtly yielded. RISK MANAGER tracked from midpack two wide, pursued in hand behind the main flight around the far turn, but only managed to chase between horses in upper stretch and lacked a bid. DUKE OF CARTHANIA trailed in the two to three path, got floated out to the six path entering the lane and made little impact. KARLWITHANARL tracked while moving outside of the leading pair and to the four path around the first turn, but chased while hung in the four path around the far turn and faded between horses.

MY BOSSY LADY tracked the clear leader from the two path around the turn, ranged up quickly to bid in upper stretch and drew off. BEAMER leaned out and bumped a rival at the start, raced well back in the four path, drifted to the six path entering the lane, rallied willingly outside of foes in the final furlong and gained place in the closing stages. SHE'S SINGLE AGAIN broke slowly and was bumped by an inner rival leaving the gate, pursued from midpack along the inside, tracked two wide and between rivals before brushing her inner counterpart turning for home, moved out to the four path in upper stretch, stayed on to edge place passing the sixteenth pole but was outkicked by an outer bidder late. MIDNIGHT MARY quickly sped clear in the opening stages, enjoyed a large advantage around the turn, but offered little resistance to an outer rival's challenge in upper stretch, weakened through the final furlong and narrolwy saved fourth. GOLDEN BONITA chased from midpack three wide and lacked a bid. MISS LOUISE lacked speed along the inside, tugged in the two path turning for home, moved between horses entering the lane, then stayed on to miss four among foes late. STINGY bumped with an outer rival leaving the gate, tracked from just off of the inside, bid up a vacated rail at the furlong grounds and kicked clear. DARYL'S BOLT was brushed into tight quarters between horses and got pinched back soon after the start, laid well back in the four to six path, delayed changing leads until the three sixteenths pole, then rallied to gain place approaching the wire. CRIMINAL DEFENSE lagged behind the rest along the inside, shifted out to the seven path leaving the three sixteenths pole and offered a belated kick to reach show at the wire. HAYHAYCAPTAIN JAC transferred contact from an inner rival to an outer foe at the start, chased closest to the clear leader and from the three path around the turn, took aim inside of that drifting rival while hanging on his left lead coming to midstretch, but was outkicked by a rail bidder entering the final furlong, yielded and got nailed at the wire for show. OVER CALENDARED brushed with an inner rival just after the start, pursued from midpack in the three path, shifted out to the five path into the lane and failed to menace. SENDEMDOWNTHEROAD broke outwardly, sped clear early on, remained in the two path around the turn, drifted out to the four path in upper stretch, got bested by an inner bidder at the furlong grounds and faded between horses. MALIBU BRAD bumped with an inner foe at the start, pursued from the two path and failed to factor.

MARDI GRAS MAMBO set a clear pace in the three path, met an inner challenge while tucking to the two path in upper stretch, turned away that bidder before being confronted by an outer rival at the furlong grounds, dueled with that one while getting headed entering the final sixteenth, yet fought back to narrowly prevail. SCOOTIN' BOOTS was brushed by an outer foe at the start, pursued from midpack in the three path, inched closer between rivals in upper stretch, bid outside of the leader at the furlong grounds, wrestled an advantage entering the final sixteenth, but failed to kick on and gave in to his inner counterpart late. TEMPLE OF PEACE chased from midpack along the inside, crept closer two wide and between horses to be behind the leader in midstretch, tipped outwardly in the final furlong, ran on taking aim late but needed more. THE FACT IS was brushed into tight quarters between horses at the start, trailed in the two to four path before moving out to the eight to nine path in upper stretch, then stayed on belatedly. NAME THE TIME tracked along the inside, bid inside of the leader in upper stretch, but lacked the needed punch and yielded. BATTLE FACE stalked in the four path and gave way. HARD CRY leaned inwardly and brushed a rival while off a step slow, raced off of the pace in the three path, bore out to the eight path entering the lane, then flopped back to his left lead and lugged inwardly at the furlong grounds while tiring. HARD KINGS lacked speed in the three to four path and made little impact.
