FATHER MARK set a pressured pace inside of a prompting foe into the turn, clung to an advantage as a wider rival bid turning for home, shook free entering upper stretch, drove clear and widened through the final furlong. HARPES HILL lacked speed in the two path, picked up stride while shifting out to the five path in upper stretch and rallied willingly to gain place in the final sixteenth. NERVY leaned out subtly at the start, chased the leading trio from the two path, shifted out to the four path entering the lane, sustained pursuit to bid for place at the sixteenth pole but got outkicked by an outer rival shortly after and narrowly prevailed for show. APRIORITY ROCKET broke a beat slow, stalked outside of the top pair into the turn, ranged up to bid at the five sixteenths pole, but failed to keep pace with his innermost counterpart in upper stretch, faded to yield place in the final sixteenth and missed show. A'DEBRIS prompted outside of the leader and eventual winner into the turn, vied between horses once an outer rival bid turning for home, then faded entering the lane. BYATHREAD trailed in the three path and failed to factor. APRIORITY AVENGER pursued off of the pace in the three path, drifted out to the five to six path entering upper stretch and tired.

BIGFOOT SIGHTING was brushed into tight rail quarters by an outer rival and forced to steady back into the first turn, pulled while hard to handle around that bend, settled into stride while applying pressure inside of the leader down the backstretch, but subtly checked back when put in tight again by his outer counterpart entering the far turn, recovered to sustain a chase turning for home, but proved no match and held place. CAJUN SWAGGER saved ground off of the pace, then ran on to narrowly gain show. WEDDING GIFT tracked form midpack in the three wo path, came under urging further off of the pace in the three path around the far turn, then stayed on mildly to miss show. HOLDEN MICHAEL pursued from midpack in the three path, yielded position between rivals with five furlongs to go, trailed in the four path around the far turn and failed to factor. DEFTLY DONE broke outwardly, raced off of the pace in the four path, advanced outside of rivals before stalking the newly clear leader from the three path around the far turn, but proved no match for that one and faded in the four path in upper stretch. MESA SPIRIT led early on as an inner rival applied mild pressure, cleared off when that one faltered into the turn, showed the way in hand in the two path around the turn, came under light urging to widen in upper stretch, responded readily and drew off under little to no urging. JUST SAY WHEN laid off of the pace along the inside, moved to the three path around the turn, entered the lane in the five path, tipped out to the seven path while building momentum entering the final furlong and ran on to gain place in the final sixteenth. ON YOUR MARK stalked forwardly in the three path, but checked slightly between horses when an inner foe bore slightly into the turn, inched place entering the lane, chased the clear leader while proving no match, but lost place in the late stages. SHUT UP MAN pursued from midpack along the inside, then in the two path around the turn, chased between horses into midstretch and lacked a bid. ATRAS leaned outwardly at the start, raced off of the pace in the four path, but was carried wide by a troubled inner rival entering the turn, recovered to pursued in the five path around the turn, crept closer fanning to the six path into the lane and flattened out. SAINT CHARLES tracked in the four path, got

brushed by an inner rival into the turn, chased turning for home and yielded between horses. PRINCE LANCELOT (GB) broke a step slow, saved ground while trailing, moved to the three path in upper stretch and failed to factor. APPEAL DENIED pressed inside of the leader early on, but failed to sustain pressure while attempting to bear out entering the turn, recovered to chase along the inside turning for home then faded. WE MISS ARLINGTON tracked two wide, but steadied behind brushing rivals into the turn, bore outside of them and carried an outer rival wider in the aftermath, faltered between horses and was outrun thereafter.

SABI pursued from midpack two wide, advanced in the four path around the far turn, bid outside of the leader while hanging on his left lead in upper stretch, changed leads to forge an advantage at the furlong grounds, drove clear and held sway. THE PADDOCK PASTOR broke a step slow, trailed two wide early on, then in the three to four path around the far turn, built momentum while swinging out to the seven path into the lane, rallied on his left lead before changing over at the furlong grounds, claimed place at the sixteenth pole then closed in on the clear leader late but was kept at bay. SIR PISTOLERO pursued from midpack along the inside, then two wide and between horses around the far turn, chased along the inside through upper stretch, tipped to gain show from between horses leaving the sixteenth pole and held that position from an outer bidder. SENDERO hopped slightly and was last away, laid well back along the inside, took the far turn in the two path before moving to the four path entering the lane, pursued behind rivals before altering course outwardly in midstretch, then ran on while hanging on his left lead, changed over late and missed reaching fourth. RIGHTHERE RIGHTNOW settled off of the pace along the inside, took the far turn in the three path, chased in the four path entering the lane and pursued evenly among foes. RUNNIN MUNNIN showed the way along the inside via a clear margin while well in hand, remained loose around the far turn, moved to the two path into the lane, but was caught by an outer bidder nearing the furlong grounds and faded. TREATY broke a beat slow and steadied out of tight quarters between horses at the start, laid off of the pace in the two to three path, entered the lane in the five path and failed to factor. MAN ON ATTACK stalked outside of the leader and from the three path, chased that clear foe around the far turn and faded between horses entering the lane. PICO D'ORO tracked along the inside, but faded while remaining in hand around the far turn and was eased through the lane. CUNIMBUS broke inwardly and bumped a rival at the start, set the pace in the two path, drew clear entering teh lane, held sway into deep stretch and lasted safely. SOUTHSCAPE transferred contact from an outer rival to an inner foe leaving the gate, settled off of the pace along the inside, took the far turn in the three to four path, tipped out to the six path at the three sixteenths pole, rallied to reach place in the final sixteenth and closed in belatedly on the clear leader. STAR ROCK STAR tracked along teh inside, gained place from an outer chaser at the three sixteenths pole, fended off an outer bidder for that position in the final furlong, but was outkicked by a wider challenge in the late stages and saved show. EMILY'S BOY took contact from an outer rival and was forced to brush an inner foe at the start, laid off of the pace two wide, swung out to the five path entering upper stretch, rallied to bid for place in midstretch, vied for that position into the final sixteenth but got outkicked by an outer rival late and missed show. TONI'S INFERNO pursued from midpack along the inside and chased willingly. EL PERFECTO bumped the inner stall door and shied from inner rivals at the start, trailed in the two path into the first turn, advanced five to four wide into the far turn, progressed to bid four deep at the five sixteenths pole, inched ahead to a clear advantage in midstretch, met an outer challenge at the sixteenth pole, drifted out while sparring with that bidder through the late stages, brushed him at the wire and narrowly held. VERACRUZIN bumped with an outer rival leaving the gate, stalked four wide before tucking two wide to pursue between horses leaving the first turn, awaited racing room behind the leaders turning for home, shifted out five wide entering the lane, sustained gradual progress to bid outside of the new leader at the sixteenth pole, but got herded outwardly by that one through the late stages and took contact while missing at the wire. IMPECCABILITY laid off of the pace along the inside, took the far turn in the

three path, pursued in the four path in upper stretch, ran on advancing between horses into the final furlong, shifted in before edging show in the final sixteenth and needed more to bid inside of the top pair. STAR READY brushed with an outer rival leaving the gate, vied along the inside, got outkicked by an outer pair of bidders turning for home yet kept on willingly thereafter. HEXCEL tracked while tucking to the inside into the first turn, took the far turn in the three path before swinging six wide into the lane, then pursued one paced. SUMMER IN AIKEN brushed with an inner foe at the start, vied two wide, got outkicked by an outer pair at the five sixteenths pole, chased between horses through upper stretch and yielded. CARTHAGE CAJUN pressed three deep, bid along with an outer rival turning for home, vied through upper stretch but faded between horses at the furlong grounds.
