FUNNY LADY leaned outwardly and bumped a rival at the start, prompted two wide, vied into the lane, battled gamely through the final furlong and prevailed. TEMPTING EVE showed the way as an outer rival applied stern pressure into and around the turn, dug in to resist that one's bid entering the lane, dueled gamely to sustain the battle through the final furlong but was bested. KISSIN RICHES raced off of the pace in the two path while keen behind rivals down the backstretch, remained held up behind foes around the turn, split rivals two wide to launch a rally in upper stretch and gained show at the sixteenth pole. PERFECT UNION was forced to bump with an inner rival by an outer foe leaving the nine sixteenths pole, pursued four wide and between horses, floated five wide into the lane, yet ran on willingly through the final furlong. CONTORTED raced forwardly along the inside, chased while subtly yielding position around the turn and failed to menace. CAN I GET AWITNESS tracked two wide and between horses, chased three wide into upper stretch and lacked a bid. MENU PLEASE (IRE) was bumped by an inner rival leaving the gate, stalked three wide, chased the embattled leading pair in upper stretch and faded. SAVE THE QUEEN was bumped between rivals leaving the nine sixteenths pole, raced off of the pace three wide and between horses, tipped four wide into the lane and lacked a rally. LA REYNITA brushed the inner stall door before brushing an inner rival at the start, trailed early on before improving position five wide into the turn, but lacked further progress and tired. PAWCATUCK took light contact from an outer rival at the start, bumped in a firmer manner with a separate outer rival passing the nine sixteenths pole, shuffled back to trail approaching the turn, then got outrun.

PRETTY SASSY took light contact from an outer foe leaving the gate, stalked along the inside while comfortably pursuing behind the leader, got outmoved by an outer bidder at the five sixteenths pole, moved two wide to take aim between horses and inside of that new leader entering upper stretch, determinedly ran on in pursuit in the final furlong, progressed to bid inside of that one at the sixteenth pole and edged past. CALIFORNIA SUNSET brushed an inner rival at the start, trailed the short field, advanced three wide and outside of rivals into and around the far turn, bid entering the lane, forged an advantage in upper stretch, inched clear into the final furlong, but was confronted by an inner challenger passing the sixteenth pole and got bested late. TRUST FUND PHILLY got fractious in the gate and popped open her stall's doors pre-race, showed the way along the inside, met an outer challenge entering the lane, got headed while inside of a pair of foes in upper stretch and yielded to them in the final furlong. SIGHT TO SEE broke through the gate when an inner rival busted open her own stall door's pre-race, pressed two wide, then faded between horses passing the five sixteenths pole.

CANAL STREET stalked along the inside, bid up a vacated rail and inside of the leader passing the quarter pole and drove clear. ROSALBA THE WICKED brushed an outer foe leaving the gate, set the pace in the two path, led as an outer rival prompted down the backstretch and around the far turn, but met an inner challenge passing the quarter pole, proved no match for that bidder and safely managed place. MOONIE PIE pressed three to two wide into the backstretch, prompted the leader while kept in the three path around the far turn, got outkicked by an inner rival nearing the lane then kept on. SWAMP QUEEN brushed with an inner foe at the start, raced forwardly two wide and between horses, chased in teh three path around the far turn and gave way. DIVA BEACH shifted off an inner rival and bumped an outer foe at the start, tracked from midpack in the two path, chased around the far turn and faded. THE RAIN IS GONE broke outwardly, raced off of the pace while taking the four path around both turns and failed to factor. CLEARsUGAR brushed with an outer foe leaving the gate, lacked speed in the three path before saving ground around the far turn, but made little impact. GLOBAL VALUE eased back from between horses early on, trailed along the inside, took the far turn in the four path and got outrun. AVIE CAKES was bumped by an inner rival soon after the start, checked back from between horses into the first turn, laid off of the pace along the inside and was done early.

ST. ARMANDS KEY stalked behind the leaders and from the two path, loomed a danger whlie pursuing from the pocket well in hand around the far turn, tipped to bid three wide entering the lane, kicked clear in upper stretch and was kept to task under mild urging. SICILIAN DEFENSE tracked from the three path, spun to the four path into the lane, chased between horses before gaining place at the furlong grounds and failed to threaten the leader. MOONLIGHT laid off of the pace three wide, improved in the four path around the far turn, moved out to the six path and between rivals in upper stretch, stayed on to gain

show in the final sixteenth and narrowly saved that position from an outer bidder at the wire. SAND PIPES steadied slightly behind rivals into the first turn, raced off of the pace along the inside under snug restraint, shifted out around the far turn, but steadied in tight quarters between horses in the five path passing the five sixteenths pole, recovered spinning to the seven path while between rivals entering the lane, then rallied belatedly to just miss reach show at the wire. UNLEASH THE POWER steadied while floating behind an inner rival's path soon after the start, raced well back along the inside, moved out to the three path turning for home and moved up between horses. NEWS AT NINE showed the way along the inside, vied with an outer prompter down the backstretch and around the far turn, but got headed by a wider bidder and proved no match in upper stretch, kept on but yielded show in the final sixteenth. SHOPPER'S REVENGE stuttered a step at the start, then checked off of rival's heels entering the first turn, trailed in the three path, altered outwardly and around a troubled rival passing the five sixteenths pole, swung eight wide into the lane and stayed on mildly. FUNNYFLAME broke a step slow and brushed with an outer foe at the start, lacked speed in the two path, gained six wide turning for home, progressed to bid for place in midstretch but emptied out and tired. MY BOY TONY pursued from midpack in the five to four path around the first turn, chased in the three path around the far turn and faded. FROST MOUNTAIN tugged in the four path and outside of the leader around the first turn, vied tucking two wide nearing the five furlong pole, sustained position around the far turn but weakened between horses in upper stretch. MIDNIGHT AWARD bobbed and brushed an inner rival at the start, pursued from midpack two wide and between horses but faded turning for home. SOVEREIGNS JOY required a shoe repair in the paddock, pursued from midpack along the inside, weakened around the far turn and was eased through the lane.

GOOD CHEER tracked along the inside, awaited racing room behind the leaders while getting outmoved by an outer rival around the far turn, committed to advance inside of rivals entering the lane, progressed and brushed her way off of the rail at the three sixteenths pole, ranged up smoothly to bid outside of the leader at the furlong grounds and drew off under mild urging. GOWELLS DELIGHT set the pace along the inside, inched free of a pair of outer mild bidders entering the lane, but offered little resistance to GOOD CHEER's bold challenge at the furlong grounds then held place. BLESS THE BROKEN laid off of the pace two to three wide, ranged up outside of the top pair around the far turn, but stalled out entering the lane and yielded four wide in upper stretch. ALEDEAN pressed outside of the leader, issued a mild challenge as an outer rival crept alongside around the far turn, failed to keep pace with the inner leader entering the lane, then faded between horses once brushed three wide at the three sixteenths pole.

MAGNITUDE showed the way unencumbered via a loose advantage, remained clear into the far turn, met a mild outer challenge turning for home, yet drew clear once again entering the lane, flopped back to his left lead entering the final furlong before changing back over shortly after and widened under a drive. CHUNK OF GOLD was nudging with the assistant starter as the gates sprung, broke a beat slow and was brushed by an outer rival at the start, laid off of the pace along the inside, attempted to launch progress tipping to the two path approaching the five sixteenths pole, but checked behind a faltering EAST

AVENUE while getting shuffled back nearing the lane, recovered and regained momentum along the inside in upper stretch and rallied up the rail to gain place in the shadow of the wire. BUILT took light contact from an outer foe leaving the gate, tracked three wide, advanced into the far turn, progressed to issue a mild bid outside of the leader turning for home, but only gained pressing position before being turned away entering the lane, pursued before tiring through the final furlong and got nailed by an inner bidder for place. VASSIMO raced forwardly along the inside while under mild yet consistent coaxing to keep pace, chased to wide and between horses passing the five furlong pole, faded between rivals around the far turn, yet swung out to the seven path in upper stretch, regained stride and came again to gain fourth late. AMERICAN PROMISE pursued from midpack along the inside, took closer order passing the five furlong pole, saved ground and gained show from an outer rival entering the lane, chased while moving to the three path in upper stretch, but lacked further progress, gave way and lost fourth late. SEPTARIAN pursued from midpack two wide, shifted to the four to five path while between horses turning for home and ran on but failed to menace. JOLLY SAMURAI trailed along the inside, swung out to the ten path into upper stretch and improved position late. RENDER JUDGMENT leaned inwardly and brushed a rival at the start, lacked speed two wide, got floated five to six wide into the lane and failed to threaten. VAMOS CARLITOS laid well back in the two to four path, moved out to the nine path into the lane and failed to factor. EAST AVENUE stalked comfortably outside of the clear leader, came under urging as an outer foe ranged alongside into the far turn, lacked a response while getting outmoved by that one at the three furlong pole, faltered between horse nearing the lane and folded. SEATTLE ROAD brushed an inner foe at the start, saved ground well back to no avail. GIOCOSO got keen into the first turn before settling off of the pace in the four path, crept closer in the three to four path around the far turn but tired between horses in upper stretch.
