REAGAN'S HONOR sent into the first turn, set all the pace from the inside and drew off to be well clear under a steady hand ride. FAVORITE DAY tracked the early leader two deep from the outside, kept on but was no match for the winner. VAMOS CARLITOS rated along to race in hand weakened off the top pair through the drive. PROCTOR PHANTOM settled back off the early pace, four wide near the quarter pole and had no late rally. YOU BELONG HERE raced from the inside around the far turn into the upper stretch and had no response. KENMORE WEST stalked the pace from the outside, ridden along three deep near the three eighths pole and was empty into the lane.
